Ministry Work Summary:

The Youth Director is responsible to support, advocate for, and develop a youth ministry with members of the church to nurture faith and a spirit of Christian community. The Youth Director will primarily be responsible for supporting and developing participation in middle school and high school youth - education, fellowship, service, and building relationships. Have commitment to the Christian faith. Demonstrate a theology in harmony with First Lutheran Church and Trinity United Methodist's mission, vision, and values. The job duties will grow and change with experience, the gifts of the person hired, and the needs of the congregations.

Responsibilities & Duties:

- Be present and build relationships with children & youth and their parents/guardians
- Develop, grow, and maintain a Youth Group for middle school and high school youth
- Stay connected with Young Adults
- Provide a joint Confirmation program and work in conjunction with the Pastors
- Manage the approved budgets for the youth programs
- Manage all Youth Ministry Dedicated Accounts
- Facilitate a summer mission trip, adventure trip, the ELCA Youth Gathering, and/or the Methodist YOUTH event on a rotating schedule
- Promote youth opportunities and communicate with families in a variety of mediums
- Network with other Children, Youth, & Family leaders in Beaver Dam, the ELCA South-Central Synod of Wisconsin, and the Wisconsin Conference of the UMC
- Work as a team member with other leaders in the church and build relationships, including a Youth Council with representatives from both churches
- Attend community events to support youth of our congregations. Encourage this to be part of the congregational life culture.
